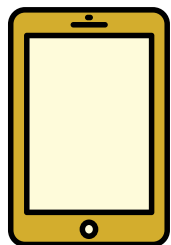

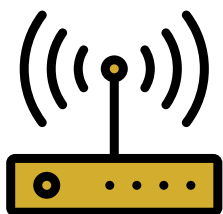
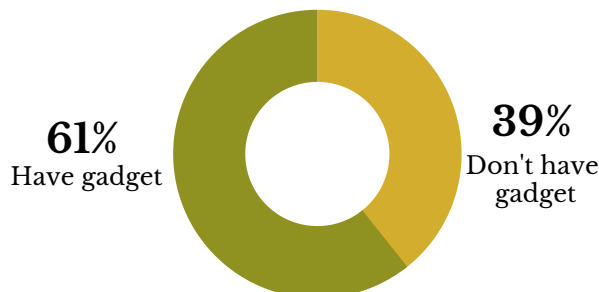
# The Impact Of Coronavirus Pandemic On La Salle Centres' Students

COVID-19 outbreak poses serious concerns to global education systems.

YLK office conducted a brief study on the impact of COVID-19 on the marginalised students of our centres. A set of questionnaires was distributed to 112 Students from both rural and urban centres on May 2021. The feedbacks were analysed and summarised as below.

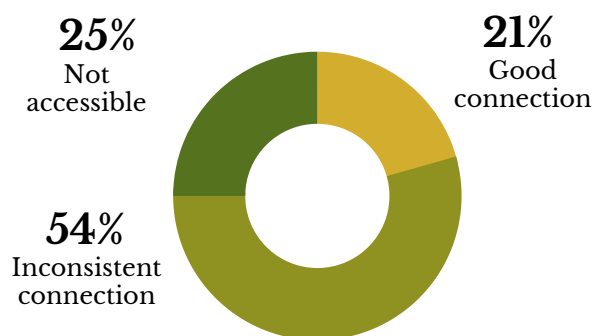


Only **68** out of **112** students have gadgets to attend online classes.



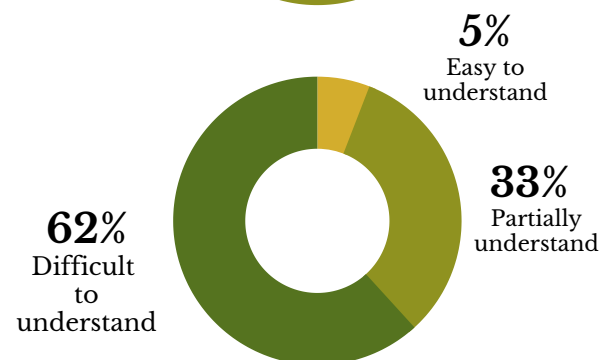
The internet accessibility at the areas of these 68 students who have gadgets are:

**21%** or 14 students have good access  
**54%** experience poor connection  
**25%** do not have any internet access



Therefore the result shows virtual lessons would benefit a handful of students only.

**5%** were able to understand the lessons.  
**33%** partially only  
**62%** had difficulty in following the lessons.
